Scholarship applicants will be judged on their leadership, community involvement, and their written essay. Special attention will be given to applicants who embody the spirit, and works of Harry Karpinski.

BOCES United Professionals reserves the right to award multiple applicants, with awards not less than \$250.00. These monies must be applied toward their pursuit of a college/vocational degree/ or certificate in a field of study that benefits society.

### Application Process:

To apply, students must complete this scholarship application in full and attach their written essay. **This application must also include a copy of their acceptance into an accredited degree/certificate granting program.**
